

Each month, the Worship Committee will answer questions about worship practices, traditions, and other matters relating to worship at Calvary. If you have specific questions, let us know and we will research the answers.

What are the pieces of the Communion Ware and do they have special names?

Fair Linen– the white cloth that covers the Altar and Altar paraments

Paten small plate– The word Paten is Latin and Greek for "plate", The Paten is designed to fit over the chalice prior to and after celebrating the Holy Supper. We place the large Host (wafer) and the purificator on the Platen.

Chalice also called Common Cup- (from Latin calix 'mug', borrowed from Ancient Greek κύλιξ (kulix) 'cup') is a footed cup used to hold sacramental wine during the Eucharist

Purificator– small white cloth with cross which is used with the Chalice. The server wipes the rim of the Chalice after each person when the Common Cup is used.

Flagon-the flagon is a pitcher used to hold the communion wine.

trays, cover– are used to hold the individual cups.

Veil– the white cloth that covers the Communion table setting

Host Box-Pyx" means "box" in Greek. Sometimes called the "bread box", the pyx is a small container, typically made of silver or gold, that holds the communion wafers prior to the consecration and distribution of the host.

Ciborium- Shaped similar to the chalice but with the addition of a cover, the ciborium holds the host in a way that combines the use of the paten and the pyx. When a ciborium is used it replaces the pyx or even the pyx and the paten. We started using the Paten instead of the ciborium when we began offering gluten free wafers. We keep the wafers separate by placing them in a separate bowl on the platen.

Calvary has a silverplate set that was purchased in honor of Frida Ernst.

We also have a tan ceramic flagon, platen, chalice and ciborium that were given in memory of Arne Gustavson.

We have a blue ceramic platen and chalice that Pastor Jenny made in ceramics class.

A Bronze tray set was purchased in memory of Lucille Thomas. It is intended to be used with the ceramic sets in order that individual cups can be offered when using the ceramics.



Carter Glennon Center for Arts and Nature is starting a new music program in Newark. We are calling it "Raise the Roof". We are partnering with the Apostolic church in Newark on, 135-137 16th avenue. They will be providing the space and renting the instruments, and Carter-Glennon will be providing the teachers to teach them. This program is made up mostly of the church members but it is also open to the community. The church is incredibly excited to be working with us and looking forward to making music in a convenient place for them. Music teaches children so many great things; discipline, confidence, teamwork, and studies show that children who do music perform better in school. There are already 14 children signed up for the program. They range in age from 8 years old to high school.

The Raise the roof program will have a band and an orchestra and will be starting Sept 24. We are trying to collect as many instruments from people who are no longer playing their instruments and that will save costs on providing instrument rentals.

Our instrument drive will go until Sept 14..but if you have committed to giving an instrument, it can be dropped off at the Uptown Flutes concert on Sept 18.
