

Celebrating Christine Souza Completing Lay Preacher Training

Calvary is delighted to share that Christine Souza has successfully completed the Lay Preacher Training Program offered by the NJ Synod's Leadership Mission Team. This program equips lay members to offer faithful, thoughtful preaching in their congregations when an ordained pastor is not available.

The training included four two-hour online courses—taught over Zoom. They covered:

- Lutheran Theology Basics, with special attention to the law/gospel distinction
- Worship Basics
- Bible Basics
- Practical Preaching Leadership, including sermon structure, delivery, and preaching resources

In addition to coursework, participants attended an all-day retreat and prepared a full sermon to share with their cohort. Upon completion, they receive a certificate recognizing their readiness to serve as a supply preacher when needed. While lay preachers are not authorized to preside at the sacraments, they play a vital role in supporting congregational worship when the pastor is away.

We are grateful for Christine's commitment and willingness to serve. She will be preaching at Calvary on Sunday, February 22.

Calvary has been chosen as one of four congregations in the New Jersey Synod to attend the ELCA's new Multiethnic & Intersectional Network, a churchwide effort to strengthen diversity, equity, and belonging across Lutheran communities.
