



Hoodies run between \$16 and \$20; t-shirts are \$3-\$5 (must be new and no graphics). A FULL SATCHEL costs about \$40. Contact Lori McCue for assistance.

Cash Giving Options

We offer several online donation methods:

Preferred Options – Zelle and Bill Pay

We encourage the use of **Zelle** or **Bill Pay** since these methods avoid the convenience fees charged by PayPal and Venmo.

Bill Pay You can also make contributions through your bank's **Online Bill Pay** service (including TD Bank and others). This option can be set up as a **one-time payment** or **recurring auto-pay**—and it avoids the 3.5% fee charged by PayPal.

Gift of Appreciated Securities

You can also donate **appreciated assets** such as **cash, bonds, stocks, or mutual funds**. To make this type of gift:

Expenses

While our offerings are down about 9% compared to last year, giving has remained steady — and we're deeply grateful for everyone's continued faithfulness and generosity. This year's revenue also includes a \$25,000 endowment draw, which has provided valuable support for our ministries and daily operations.

On the expense side, costs have risen a bit more than \$20,000 from last year (excluding one-time items). Increases in utilities, payroll, alarm maintenance and monitoring and new programing, reflect the real costs of keeping Calvary safe, welcoming, and fully operational. Thanks to your ongoing support, we're able to continue serving our congregation and community with strength and purpose.

Together, we can finish the year strong and continue building a vibrant ministry for the year ahead!


We ask that you consider any names that you previously submitted. If the person no longer needs ongoing prayer, please let us know so we can remove them from the list.


