Positive Tails is a non-profit organization founded in 2013, working in conjunction with <u>VERG</u> and other partner veterinary hospitals.

Our mission is to improve both animal and community welfare in New York City, in three ways: 1) We provide funding for lifesaving emergency veterinary care for those who can't afford treatment, or for animals who are abandoned or abused. 2) We organize and hold an average of 9 veterinary and One Health Clinics for people

who can't afford or don't have access to veterinary care for their animals. 3) We provide follow up care and spay/neuter services to help animals lead long, healthy lives, and to control the incidence of unwanted animals.






